MEMBERSHIP

Membership is from 1st May until 30th April.

NEW MEMBERS

If you wish to join our club you should complete a Membership form which you can find on our website.

HOURS OF PLAY

The courts may be used from 8 am until 10 pm except for the clay courts which can only be used until 9.30 pm.

FLOODLIGHTS

Floodlights are operated by meters in the kitchen. The cost is £4 for 1 hour and will need to be paid for by the players. Floodlights are provided free of charge during club nights, match practice and club coaching.

TENNIS BALLS

Tennis balls will be provided for home matches and for club coaching.

MATCH PRACTICE

Match practice takes place on Thursday evenings from 5.30 pm onwards for all teams. This is open to all team players.

BOX LEAGUE

All members are welcome to participate in the singles box league which is played throughout the year.

TENNIS COACHING

Available for individuals and groups, team players, juniors and junior squad groups. Contact the Head Coach.

ACCESS TO CLUB HOUSE

All adult members can request a key to the club house by contacting one of the Committee members. The keys are kept behind the bar. The club house must be vacated by 10 pm except where prior agreement has been obtained.

COURT BOOKINGS

An on-line court booking system can be accessed from our website. On joining our club you will be provided with login details and the rules associated with the booking of courts.

ADULT CLUB SESSIONS

The adult club sessions for full members take place on Tuesday evenings starting at 5.30 pm. From April to October supper is provided during the evening session for a small charge.

Improver and beginner sessions take place on Monday and Wednesday evenings in groups (with coaching available at extra cost).

JUNIOR CLUB SESSIONS

The junior club sessions take place Monday to Saturday with Junior Social Friday nights and weekly competitions on Sunday Afternoons.

VISITORS

Members can have a maximum of three visits by guests in each subscription year. The visitor's name must be entered in the Visitor's Book kept in the club house and a visitor's fee of £3 will apply. The member must collect the fee, accompany the visitor during their stay and is liable for their conduct.

Before each use of the clay courts they need to be brushed in a circular motion using the court brush. Brushing or playing on the clay courts is not allowed if snow has settled on the surface.
